Without these supports, the risk of relapse, legal setbacks, or instability increases dramatically.

That is why case management is not treated as an optional add-on at Troopers. It is a mandatory service for every resident, built into the very structure of our program.

What We Provide

- **Individualized Planning:** Every resident is assigned a case manager who creates a tailored recovery plan with clear goals and timelines.
- **Housing, Employment & Education Support:** We help residents apply for housing, find jobs, and connect to GED or vocational programs to build independence
- **Healthcare Coordination:** Case managers ensure access to medical, psychiatric, and therapy services while supporting medication compliance.
- **Probation/Parole Accountability:** We maintain communication with APPO, monitor curfews, and provide documentation to keep residents in compliance.
